

THE DAKOTA ACCESS PIPELINE: Economic Impact To Date



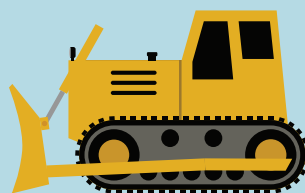
